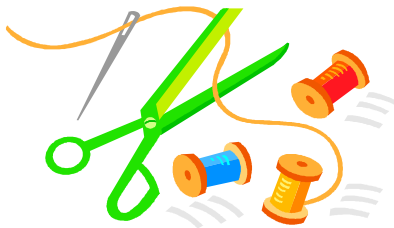

**Friday: Details Count.** Buttonholes got you buffaloed? Zippers got you zapped? Do grippers, thread loops, hook & loop tape, and snaps have you sparled? This notebook class presents fresh approaches to many of the pitfalls of clothing construction. Even if you have been sewing for years, this class will enhance your skills. (Machine required) 6 hours; 2 Artisan points.

**Saturday: Advance Smocking & Technique Enhancement: Beyond the Basics** A survey of interesting, less well-known smocking stitches including Van Dyke, honeycomb, feather, and herringbone. A detailed instruction booklet with both left & right hand illustrations provided. 3 hours, 1 Artisan point.

**Enchanting Embellishments** A unique selection of embellishment variations using chain stitch, common knots, bias tubing; sheaf & blanket stitch (among others) to add polish to any garment. 3 hours, 1 Artisan point.
